

What To Expect After Your Pet's Vaccines

Congratulations! By vaccinating, you have taken an important step towards protecting your pet!

It's common for your pet to experience mild side effects from vaccination. Typically starting within hours, symptoms are most often mild and do not persist more than a few days. This is a normal response by your pet's immune system during the process of developing protective immunity!

Common Symptoms Your Pet May Experience

Discomfort or mild swelling at injection site
Decrease in appetite and/or activity or mild lethargy
Sneezing after the Bordetella intranasal vaccine

More serious, but less common side effects, such as allergic reactions, may occur within minutes to hours after vaccination. These reactions can be life-threatening and are medical emergencies!

Rare Symptoms Include

Facial swelling
Hives
Weakness, collapse, pale gums
Difficulty breathing
Repeated vomiting/diarrhea
